Due to their value, videos must **not** be sent through Canada Post but must be shipped with UPS or another courier company. This allows us to track the videos and protects you and/or your church from the cost of replacing lost video's or DVD's. Videos must be returned in the container they were sent in and placed in an appropriately sized box or bubble envelope.
